- ♣ Student Last Name

- Student First Name(s)
- Student Email Address
- ♣ Date of Birth (DD/MM/YYYY format)
- ♣ Term(s) and year of Exchange (First Semester, Second Semester or Full Year)
- Level of Study (Undergraduate or Graduate)
- Degree/Study Program at Home Institution
- English Language Test Score, Type & Date Completed

\*Note: Proof of English proficiency is required for students whose first language is NOT English

## Minimum English Language Requirements

- ♣ International English Language Testing System (IELTS) with a minimum test score of 7.0
- Cambridge English Language Assessment (CAE) with a minimum of 185 points.

#### Course Selection

- Course availability is subject to change and for this reason we cannot guarantee registration in specific courses. For exchange term(s) at WITS, students should create a study plan that includes a mixture of courses from their major, minor and most especially free electives.
- The courses listed on an Incoming Exchange Application form will be reviewed by departmental advisors at Wits. If courses have been selected from more than one discipline, a request will be sent to the designated department contact for each discipline.
- Our academic departments will determine which courses an exchange student is approved to take. Each department has their own criteria when assessing course requests, the most important of which is whether a student has the

# required academic background to meet the course prerequisites.

#### **TO NOTE**

- A student may **not** be approved to take all the courses they have requested on their application. This can be due to several factors, including but not limited to the
  - Course is restricted and not open to exchange students,
  - o Course is full
  - o Course is not offered in correct exchange term
  - o Course is cancelled
  - o Course conflicts with other registered courses
  - o The student does not meet the academic prerequisites to take the course
- ♣ Students requesting full year courses must be prepared to complete both terms of the course (i.e. Semester One and Two) to receive academic credit for the course. This applies even if the course is offered online.

## E. Accommodation

On-Campus Housing

Accommodation fees for International House = +/- R391.00 per day (fee includes a single residence room, access to Wi-Fi)

The total cost must be paid on or before check-in. The payment can be made by credit card (Visa, Mastercard or Visa/Debit card).

Off-Campus Housing

Students are responsible for securing their own off-campus accommodation. Students seeking off-campus accommodation are advised to independently verify the suitability and safety of any property.
