



Undergraduate Full-Time Information for International Students

Provisional Offer:

- does not guarantee admission,
- can be used to apply for a study visa. Remember to request for the letter of undertaking from the International Students Office StudySA.International@wits.ac.za,
- may not be confirmed if the applicant has failed to maintain a high standard of academic performance relative to the cohort of applicants.

Please note travel arrangements and payment to the University must only be confirmed after you have received the firm offer and study visa.

Firm Offer and Registration:

You may only proceed to register once you have:

- a **firm offer** from Wits University,
- a valid study visa for Wits University issued from the Department of Home Affairs, Remember to request for the letter of undertaking from the International Students Office StudySA.International@wits.ac.za,
- successfully fulfilled all prerequisite registration steps.

Prerequisite Steps for Registration:

International students are required to:

- pay 75% of the annual tuition fees, related costs, and on-campus accommodation (where applicable) prior to registration. The balance must be paid by 30 June 2025. Complete the [On-line Fee Estimator](#) for the approximate costs and banking details.
- provide proof of Medical Aid cover with a South African based medical aid scheme for the full calendar, i.e., until 31 December 2025,
- have a valid Passport,
- have a valid study visa for Wits University.

No firm offers will be made to international applicants after 18 January 2025.

If there is good reason for you not being able to register within the timeframe stipulated in your firm offer letter, you must inform the University in writing by sending an email to Registrar@wits.ac.za by no later than **22 January 2025**. In the communication provide your name, student number, faculty, programme, and reason.

The University may reinstate the reservation of your place at its discretion.
